God said to Job, “Hast thou entered into the treasures of the snow? or hast thou seen the treasures of the hail” (Job. 38:22).

First, snow refreshes the earth. Isaiah scribed, “For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater” (Isa. 55:10).

The Bible also informs the reader how a cold refreshing snow resembles the sweet words of a faithful messenger. Solomon wrote, “As the cold of snow in the time of harvest, so is a faithful messenger to them that send him: for he refresheth the soul of his masters” (Prov. 25:13).

And most importantly, the whiteness of snow serves as a reminder of the cleansing power of Christ on the soul. Isaiah proclaimed, “Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool” (Isa. 1:18).

So the next time you see the snow grace the ground think of what Jesus did for you. Think about the day of your new birth when you entered the waters of baptism and had your sins washed away. And then pause to thank God for the snow.

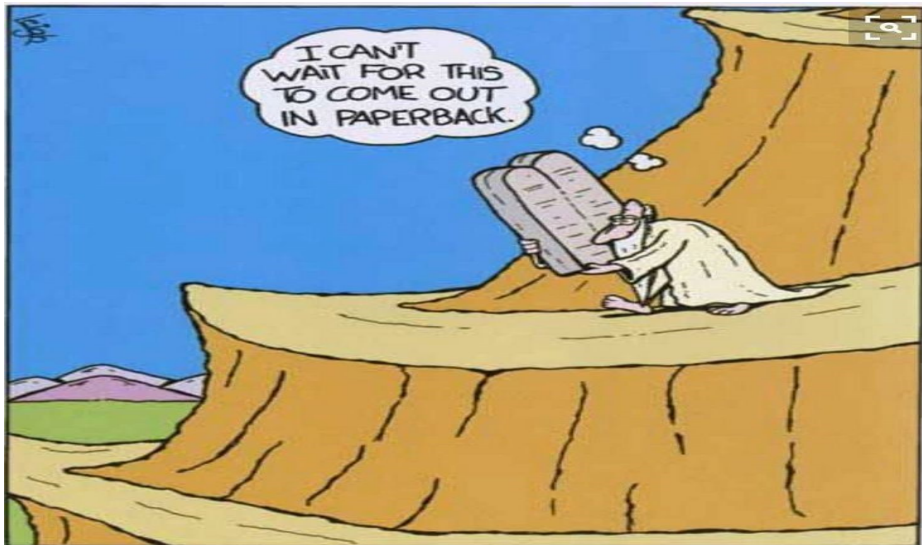
