## **AS LONG AS I CAN SEE THE LIGHT**

*“The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up”* (Matt. 4:16). Every time I see a lighthouse it reminds me of this verse about Jesus.

The first American lighthouse (as far as we know) was a stone tower built by the colony of Massachusetts and lit for the first time on September 14, 1716, on Little Brewster Island (then called Beacon Island) in Boston Harbor. Unfortunately this lighthouse doesn't survive; retreating British troops blew it up on June 13, 1776. The oldest still standing is the colonial lighthouse at **Sandy Hook, New Jersey**, the southern entrance to New York Harbor.

Two thousand years ago a light was brought into the world that would shine eternally. It illuminated from the Messiah and was embedded in the saints. Like a lighthouse this beacon of hope shines to those lost at sea. Forever beaconing for the wanderers to leave the darkness
