THE HOLY BIBLE

Which book is longest in the Bible? You may say, "The book of Psalms." Yet, if we were to take a word count our top ten would look like this: **Kings** (39,145 words) **Chronicles** (38,013 words) **Samuel** (38,007 words) **Jeremiah** (32,982 words) **Genesis** (32,046 words) **Psalms** (30,047 words) **Ezekiel** (29,918 words) **Exodus** (25, 957 words) **Isaiah** (25,608 words) **Numbers** (25,048 words).

The Bible was written in three languages: Hebrew, Aramaic, and Koine Greek. It is 611,000 words long written by 40 different inspired men. There are 185 songs in the bible, and 150 of them are located in the book of Psalms.

The Bible itself was written on three continents. Most was written in what is modern-day Israel (Asia). But some passages of Jeremiah were written in Egypt (Africa) and several New Testament epistles were written from cities in Europe.

In the Old Testament, Moses writes the most books, and in the New, Paul pens the vast majority. Both men were murderers, and both were called directly by God. Moses on the mount gazing into the burning bush, and Paul on the road to Damascus blinded by the light.

The first printed Bible did not occur until the 22 of October, 1454 by Johannes Gutenberg. It has been the number one seller ever since.
