“For we know in part, and we prophesy in part. But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away” (1 Cor. 13:9, 10).

So many fail to understand the purpose and practice of miracles. According to John 20:30, 31, they were performed by Christ as a signature to His Messiahship. The apostles would continue them for the sole reason of proving the resurrection.

Paul makes it clear that miracles were going to cease when he writes to the brethren at Corinth. When? When the PERFECT THING would come! And what was that PERFECT THING? The word in its completion according to James 1:25 where it is called the PERFECT LAW OF LIBERTY.

Even further, only through the apostles hands could the gift of the Spirit be given (Acts 8:18). And since there are no apostles living today (Acts 1:21, 22), one can conclude that the miracles are no longer.

This was meant to happen for the furtherance of the faith. For it was Jesus who said, “Blessed are they who believe and have no seen!” (Jn. 20:29). Faith is *“the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen”* (Heb. 11:1). Hence, the actual believing in those things never seen becomes the stepping-stone of faith.
