"Thou shalt not go up and down as a talebearer among thy people: neither shalt thou stand against the blood of thy neighbour: I am the LORD" (Lev. 19:16). "He that goeth about as a talebearer revealeth secrets: therefore meddle not with him that flattereth with his lips" (Prov. 20:19).

A few men, one day, were sitting and talking. One exclaimed, "Have you heard about the new kid in town?" "No!," said his friends. "Well he is a problem for this community.
