#### THE HEALING JEHOVAH

The Bible mentions 128 plants that were part of everyday life in ancient Israel and its Mediterranean neighbors. These plants include almonds, apples, black mustard, cucumber, grapes, mandrake, nettle, poppy, and wormwood.

What is important to understand focuses on the fact that God placed man in an environment that would eventually kill him. Once Adam and Eve were cast out of the garden, they became dependent on farming and hard work to sustain themselves (Gen. 3:17-19).

They would feel the frailty of the human body and spirit. Sicknesses, aches, and pains would be passed on to generation after generation. Yet God provided remedies for His creation.

Even surgical techniques in the ancient world could be surprisingly advanced. The famous Roman physician Galen (c. 129–199 A.D.), who was born in ancient Pergamon near the Asklepion, is generally regarded as the most accomplished medical researcher of the Roman world, and some of his surgical procedures would not be seen again until modern times. He successfully conducted cataract surgeries by inserting a needle behind the lens of the eye in order to remove the cataract, and his described methods of preparing a clean operating theater reveal a keen awareness of contagion.

The greatest techniques and cures were no doubt through God's intervention (James 5:14). The power of prayer and faith centered on the greatest physician of all, JESUS CHRIST!


