GOLGOTHA

In the Aramaic Golgotha means “skull.” Many believe the name was given for the shape of the hill outside of Jerusalem where prisoners were executed. It is referred to in all four gospels (**Matt. 27:33; Mark 15:22; Lk. 23:33; John 19:17**). The place is also called Calvary from the Greek word *kranion* which indicates part of the skeletal frame known as the cranium.

There are several reasons Jesus was crucified in this location. First, it was a place **visible** for the travelers going in and out of Jerusalem. Paul once proclaimed, *“For I think that God hath set forth us the apostles last, as it were appointed to death: for we are made a spectacle unto the world, and to angels, and to men”* (1 Cor. 4:9).

Second, it was a place of **vision**. From that Cross, the Lord viewed the people, His mother, and the holy city that He once said, *“O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, thou that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would not!”* (Matt. 23:37).

Last, but not least, it was a place of **victory**. It was Paul who wrote, *“But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ”* (1 Cor. 15:57).

As the song reads, *“In that old rugged cross, stained with blood so divine, A wondrous beauty I see, For twas on that old cross Jesus suffered and died, To pardon and sanctify me.”*
