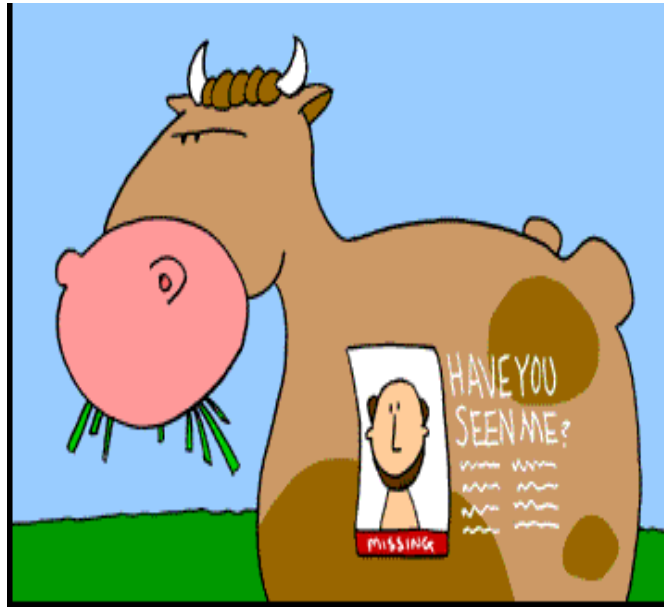

“For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth:
and the former shall not be remembered, nor come into
mind” (Isa. 65:17). “For as the new heavens and the
new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me,
saith the LORD, so shall your seed and your name re-
main” (Isa. 66:22). “Nevertheless we, according to his
promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein
dwelleth righteousness” (2 Pet. 3:13). “And I saw a
new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and
the first earth were passed away; and there was no more
sea” (Rev. 21:1). Isaiah speaks of the new age for the
Jewish nation, and then concludes his book by speaking
about the coming kingdom built by the Messiah which
would be the church.

Peter and John focus on heaven where no sin exists,
but only righteousness and peace. Something they
longed for, and were willing to sacrifice to achieve.

In all four accounts, where this phrase is used, it is
apparent that the world men lived in was not enough.
There was no hope, and it was void of change. Yet this
new heaven and earth would offer what the old world
could not. For the Jews, it was the freedom from bond-
age. And for the saint, it was the hope of heaven and
living among the angels.

John was so over joyed by seeing this vision of the
new heaven and new earth that he was willing to shed
his mortal body and be with Christ at that very moment.
Hence, the question, “Are we that excited as those early
disciples to leave this mortal frame for the heavenly?”
