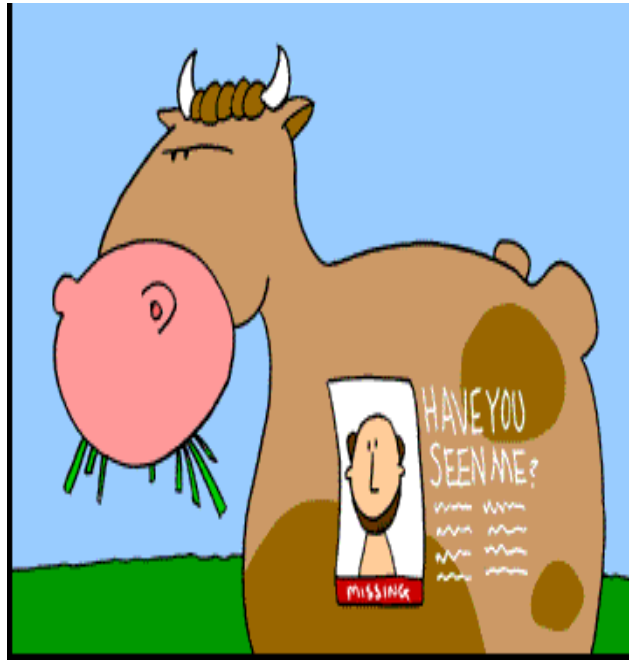

We just recently celebrated Memorial Day. Millions of people traveled to cemeteries to place flags upon the graves of men and women who served to keep our country free.

Yet, have you ever thought about those who died throughout the centuries for simply following Jesus? The Hebrew writer exclaimed, *“These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth”* (Heb. 11:13).

There are no grave to place flags or flowers upon for Paul, John, Peter, or the many saints who were burned on crosses, thrown into the arena, or beheaded by the axe. Their battles were just as fierce, and dangerous as the beaches at Normandy, or Guadalcanal where many Americans lost their lives. And their weapons were not made with human hands, but by the yielding power of God who motivated them to face their accusers with dignity and humility.

The book of Revelation, pointing to the annihilation of Rome, mentions on several occasions Satan making war with the saints (Rev. 11:7, 13:7, 17:14, 19:19). He is represented as a fiery dragon who feeds upon the sufferings of the righteous. Howbeit, John is shown the judgment of this enemy of God as he is seen at the end of the book being thrown in the lake of fire to burn eternally (Rev. 20:10).

So as we each year honor our dead who served this nation, I hope we will not forget the righteous who gave their lives for Jesus.

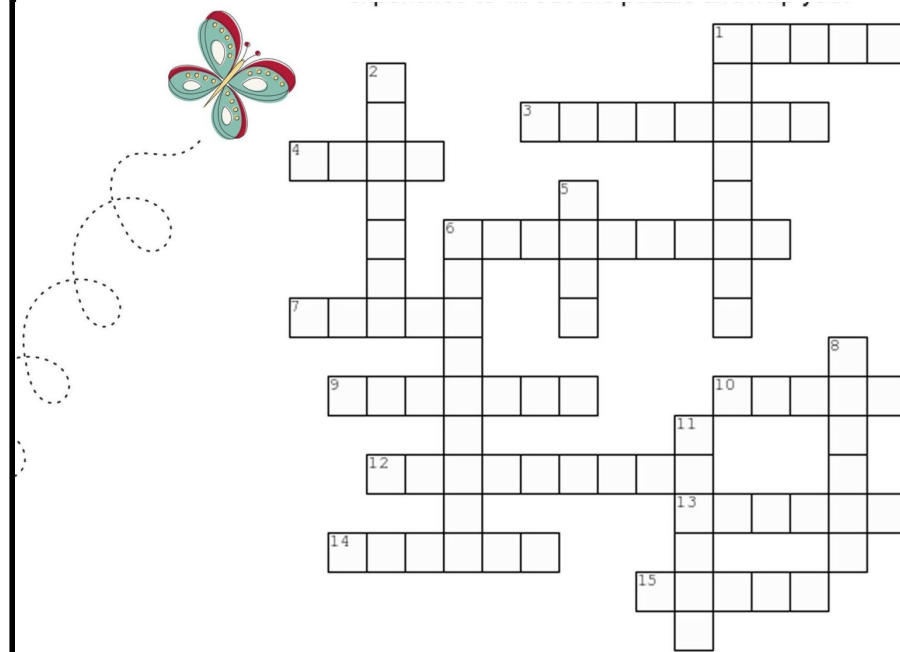
