“For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not” (Eccl. 7:20). Paul quoting from Psalm 14:1-3 wrote, *“As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one: There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God. They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one”* (Rom. 3:10-12). I believe we can so easily fall into the trap of pride and arrogance. What brings the Christian back into focus is the fact that by our own merit we are not good enough to stand in the presence of God. Eliphaz asked Job, *“How much more abominable and filthy is man, which drinketh iniquity like water?”* (Job 15:16). And Isaiah proclaimed, *“But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away”* (Isa. 64:6). The amazing power of the blood of Christ is that it purifies the soul, and transforms the unworthy into worthy.

So as I view myself in the mirror, I see a man who is so pitifully marred that I ponder on why Jesus would want to save a wretch like me! And then I remember the words to my favorite hymn, *“Amazing grace how sweet the sound that saved a wretch like me. I once was lost, but now I'm found, was blind but now I see.”*

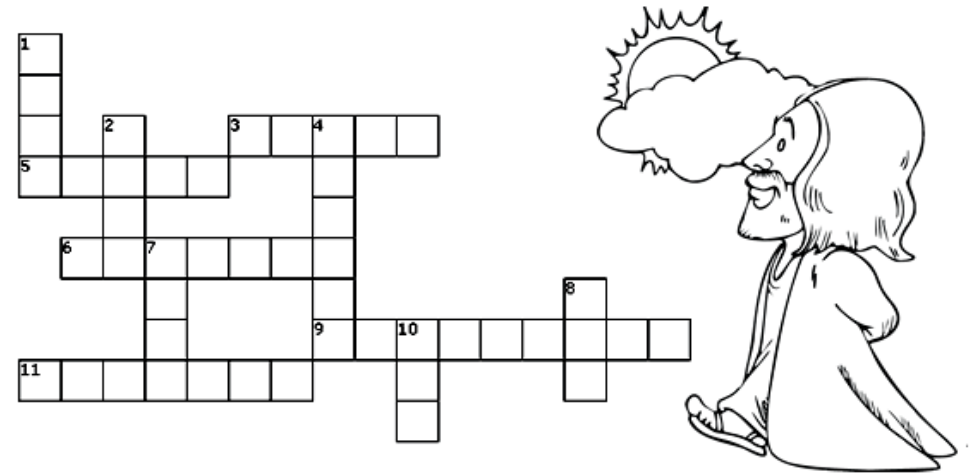
