“Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the name of the LORD our God” (Psa. 20:7). The United States has some of the most powerful weapons on the planet. We have a military that is far superior to many others. Yet what is that to God. In Daniel 2, the great prophet interprets Nebuchadnezzar’s dream. It speaks of the rising and falling of four great empires (Babylon, Medo-Persian, Grecian, Roman). They are the only four in history that would rule the world.

David professes several facts about God ruling the nations. He writes, *“Put them in fear, O LORD: that the nations may know themselves to be but men”* (Psa. 9:20). Again he proclaims, *“For the kingdom is the LORD’S: and he is the governor among the nations”* (Psa. 22:8). And he further exclaims, *“Who smote great nations, and slew mighty kings”* (Psa. 135:10). All these passages echo the fact that God is the one who allows nations to rise and He is the destroyer of nations when they are overtaken by sin.

Brethren, we need to pray for America. Not only for the fact that we love this country, but that we wish to see the people look to God as their Redeemer and Protector. Let’s support the position that is stamped on our coinage, *“In God we trust!”*
