“*But we were **gentle** among you, even as a nurse cherisheth her children*” (1 Thess. 2:7). “*And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be **gentle** unto all men, apt to teach, patient*” (2 Tim. 2:24). “*To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but **gentle**, shewing all meekness unto all men*” (Tit. 3:2).

And unlike the uniformed soldier that marches out to the battlefield, not knowing if they shall emerge victorious; we as saints know the ending to the battle and the story.


