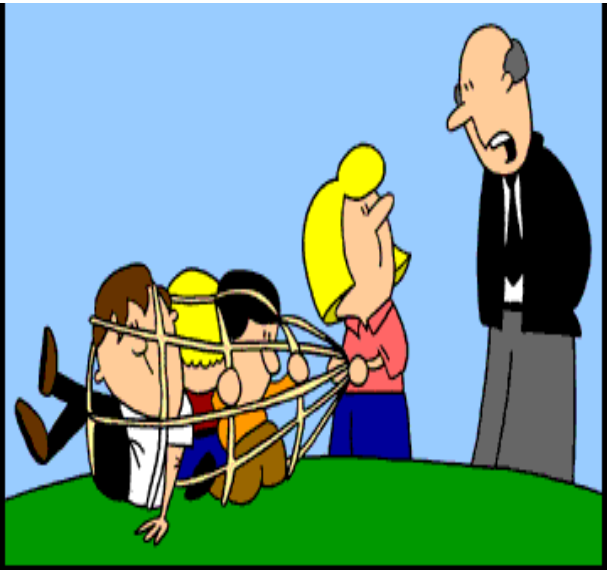

*“For thou bringest certain strange things to our ears: we would know therefore what these things mean. For all the Athenians and strangers which were there spent their time in nothing else, but either to tell, or to hear some new thing”* (Acts 17:20, 21). The Stoics and the Epicureans in Athens were groups that supposedly sought truth but were more engaged in wanting to hear new things.

I believe that period and response to the gospel was a prelude to the twenty-first century philosophy. For the Athenians engaged in three main thoughts.

**First**, they were more interested in following the **man** rather than the **plan**. The two philosophers who founded these schools of thought were Zeno and Epicurus, who lived 300 years before Jesus.

**Second**, the Athenians were more concerned with **emotions** rather than **devotion**. That march of Paul’s up Mar’s Hill unveiled a people who had no idea who Jesus was! Nor did they understand the meaning of total devotion to the one true God!

Third, the Athenians were more likely to follow **deception** rather than be **directed by** truth. Jesus warned His disciples concerning deception (Lk. 21:8). And in the book of Revelation, one finds the nations deceived by the devil (Rev. 18:23, 19:20, 20:10).

Yes! Indeed! The same damnable philosophies have built mega-churches and seeded false teachers who engage in driving the hearts of men toward destruction and despair. For the heart moving source which will bring hope and save the soul is word of God!

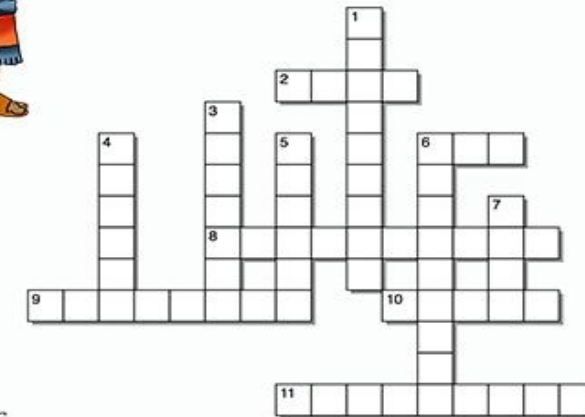
