DEALING WITH DEPRESSION

It is well documented that Abraham Lincoln was melancholic to say the least. He suffered from depression throughout his life. His mother died when he was nine, and his brother died before he left the home. It is said that he had few friends and was often seen crying profusely.

How often the Lord spoke to His apostle about joy, but He Himself had periods of deep depression? The angel that appeared to the shepherds in the field exclaimed, *“And thou shalt have joy and gladness; and many shall rejoice at his birth”* (Lk. 2:10). His tears flowed at the death of Lazarus because of the people’s unbelief (Jn. 11). And then there was the garden episode where our Lord prostrated Himself on the ground in turmoil (Mark 14:36).

No matter how hard we try to stay positive there are going to be trials in our lives that will test us to the max. Sometimes these periods are short, and sometimes they last many years.

Jesus gave us one of the best aids when going through depression in that garden. Matthew records, *“Then cometh Jesus with them unto a place called Gethsemane, and saith unto the disciples, Sit ye here, while I go and pray yonder. And he took with him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and began to be sorrowful and very heavy. Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: tarry ye here, and watch with me”* (Matt. 26:36-38).

The Creator of the universe, the Savior of mankind, and the King of Kings needed His friends to simply be there for Him in this trying time. He did not need them to converse, encourage Him, or direct Him; He knew what He needed to do.

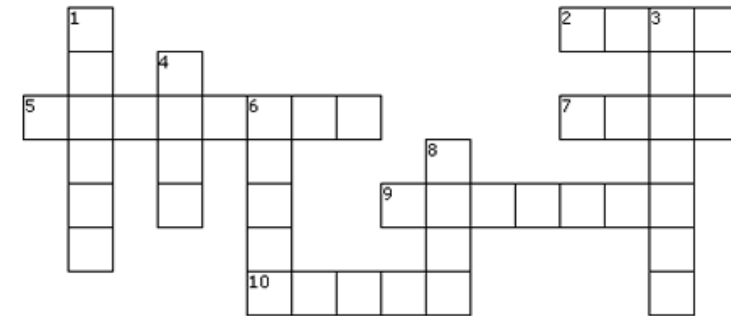
