## THE TRUE VALUE OF FELLOWSHIP

For years you've heard the preachers talk about attendance and fellowship. We sometimes believe that he is simply meddling and not preaching. David wrote, "Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!" (Psa. 133:1).

For a moment I want you to think about why we fellowship. First, it **solidifies** the church. It was Paul who wrote to the brethren at Philippi, "For God is my record, how greatly I long after you all in the bowels of Jesus Christ (Phil. 1:8).

Second, it brings **security** to the believers. Six verses down from Hebrews 10:25 is Paul's warning, "It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God" (Heb. 10:31). I want to secure my mansion in heaven and I cant do that when I fail in fellowshiping others.

Third, the **savior's** presence is part of the assembly. Jesus said, "For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them" (Matt. 18:20). Every time I come together with my church family, I feel His presence. I pray you do also. And when you are missing, a part of myself is missing. God brought me to this congregation. You didn't need me; I needed you!

Fourth, it brings **satisfaction** to the Father. In Acts 2 and 4, you can feel the radiant love the brethren had for each other. It directly correlates with David's pronouncement in Psalms 133:1. I feel so encouraged when I embrace the coming together of the saints. I cannot wait to go to heaven with all of you. I am so excited to partake of the Lord's Supper with the Savior of my soul!
