WHY IS GRACE SO AMAZING?

"Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began" (2 Tim. 1:9). Almost every letter written by Paul begins with a salutation on grace. There are basically three reasons for the proclamation that grace is amazing: character, Creator, and conditions.

First, what is **character? Webster** defines it **as** "the mental and moral qualities distinctive to an individual." Howbeit we are talking about an attribute, an invisible yet invincible gift from the Lord. Paul wrote to Titus, "For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men" (**Titus 2:11**). So, Paul says it is not prejudicial. It extends it's reach to all men!

Second, who is the **Creator** of grace? The Bible makes it clear that the originator of grace is none other than Jesus, John exclaimed, "For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ" (Jn. 1:17). The word grace is used a little over forty times in the Old Testament and 130 times in the New.

Thirdly, there are **conditions** for grace. It is hard to perceive that grace being free would require any action by the recipient. Yet the Bible presents three necessities for the reception of God's grace: 1) righteousness, 2) obedience, 3) steadfastness. Noah found grace given to him by God because of his righteousness (Heb. 11:7). And it was Samuel who said, "Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams" (1 Sam. 15:22). Then concerning "steadfastness," it was the Hebrew writer who proclaimed, "For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end" (Heb. 3:14).

So, I leave you with Paul's salutation, "The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen" (Rom. 16:24).
